Greetings from the City Operation Office of Naga City!

The Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program is one of the national government's poverty alleviation programs that contributes to breaking the intergenerational cycle of poverty, and the Departments of Education and Health are the key partner agencies that support the program to ensure that certain program conditions, particularly those related to education and health, are met by the beneficiaries.

There was an update and transition on the DepEd curriculum for the K-12 curriculum, covering kindergarten and 12 years of basic education. The program aims to provide sufficient time for mastery of concepts and skills, develop lifelong learners, and prepare graduates for tertiary education, middle-level skills development, employment, and entrepreneurship, which brings with it challenges and tribulations not only for the department but also for the partner agencies. In response to the transition's problems, new guidelines were developed. Succeeding pregnancy, LRN validation, inter-regional monitoring, and Bata Balik Eskwela activity anchored to the strategic priority of the program are among the rules and recommendations.

To ensure the program's proper and effective execution, a one-day consultation activity will be held to coordinate, distribute, and review the new program policies and guidelines with the DepEd staff. The objectives of this consultation are as follows:

- The stakeholders from DEPED will be more program-oriented by being able to respond to queries on program conditionalities and more equipped by their main responsibilities towards program operations.
- To serve as the venue to showcase the good practices of selected schools for replications, particularly on the Bata Balik Eskwela Campaign and Malusog na Bata, and will harmonize existing mechanisms and processes to address concerns on NAS.
- Lastly, the knowledge to be acquired during the activity will be shared with their co-stakeholders in their respective areas for the smooth implementation of the program.

With regard to this, we would like to request the School Heads or the 4P's Coordinators of every school here in Naga City to attend the abovementioned activity on February 19, 2024, (8 am – 5 pm) in Jessie M. Robredo Museum, Concepcion Pequeña, Naga City. Their presence will be highly appreciated.
