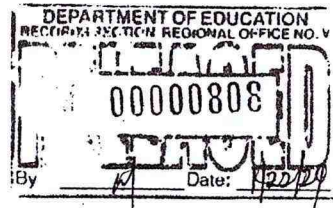

REGIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOP ON EDUCATION IN EMERGENCIES (EIE)

To : Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. In support to the DepEd's MATATAG agenda in ensuring that education shall continue even in times of emergencies/disasters regardless of the circumstances surrounding the situation, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) shall conduct the **Regional Training Workshop on Education in Emergencies (EIE) on March 27-30, 2024, within Legazpi City**. The specific venue shall be released in a separate issuance.

2. This three-day training workshop aims to:

- orient and capacitate educational leaders and school heads in the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and schools on ADM Education in Emergencies, on the prescribed reporting templates using the Rapid Damage Assessment Report (RADAR) and review session guides for the conduct of the Psychological First Aid (PFA) for learners and teachers,
- strengthen the commitment of Schools Division Offices (SDOs), and schools in the implementation of ADM-Education in Emergencies; and
- develop a division/school plan for echo training, and Learning Continuity Plan for their respective divisions/schools and the

3. The participants to this Activity are the following: 13 Division ADM Focal Persons, 13 Division DRRM Focal Persons, 13 Division MHPSS Focal Persons, 40 selected secondary school heads (at least 4 SH from province divisions and 2 from city divisions), 40 elementary school heads (at least 4 from province divisions and 2 from city divisions), selected RO Personnel from CLMD and ESSD and the TWG.

4. Confirmation of attendance is requested to be emailed to Nora Laguda, EPS, CLMD on or before March 15, 2024. Details of logistical arrangements shall be released in a separate issuance.

5. Services rendered on March 30, 2024, Saturday, shall be granted with service credits/COC, whichever is applicable, subject to existing rules and regulations.

6. Travel, and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Meals, accommodation, and training materials during the training shall be charged to DPRP continuing funds.

6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
