- 2. The Regional Research Committee (RRC) shall manage research initiatives at the regional level to provide guidance on research directions, particularly in aligning such initiatives with the national and local Basic Education Research Agenda. The Regional Research Committee shall spearhead the call for proposals, evaluation, approval, and grant of available funds for research proposals, partnerships, and dissemination of results.
- 3. The following are the roles and responsibilities of the RRC:
 - a. Provide directions on research initiatives through the national and local Basic Education Agenda, and other identified priority research areas in the region;
 - b. Evaluate and approve research proposals and other related research initiatives from the region and schools division, in particular, proposals to be funded under BERF or any other fund source lodged in the region;
 - c. Confirm school research proposals endorsed by the Schools Division Research Committee (SDRC) unless the committee finds major issue(s) in the approved research proposals (i.e. finance/cost estimates, among others);
 - d. Forge partnerships with academic and research institutions on education research initiatives and projects;
 - e. Resolve emerging issues on the management and conduct of research;
 - f. Recommend release of regional research funds;
 - g. Provide feedback to the Regional Executive Committee on approved, ongoing, and completed research;
 - h. Ensure that cost estimates fall under the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations; and
 - i. Endorse appropriate research proposals for consideration as national level proposals to the NRC.


