





Event: **Philippine Folk Dance**

Key Stage: Key Stage 2 (Grade 4 to 6)

No. of Participants: 6 learner-participants either from Key Stage Two per school

Time Allotment: Maximum of 5 minutes

Contest Venue: Mac Mariano ES Pavilion

Contest Administrator: Pemie P. Bosquillos

Date of Contest: May 13, 2022

Criteria for Presentation:

Performance (Spacing, Formations, Execution Showmanship)	40%
Interpretation of Written Instructions	25%
Stagging	25%
Overall Impact	10%
Total	100%

Event Rules and Mechanics:

- A. The objective of this show case is to promote appreciation and understanding of the folkdances of the region. It aims to raise the awareness of the people on culture and the arts through folk dance performances.
- B. Only 1 entry per school is allowed.
- C. A minimum of six (6) performers and I teacher-coach shall be allowed per school.
- D. The dance literature is a rural folk dance highlighting mimetic activity.
- E. The dance must be from any published Philippine folkdance books.
- F. The dance maybe accompanied by canned music prescribed by the book. Live accompaniment is not allowed.
- G. Medley (Combination) of different dances is not allowed.
- H. In dances where the literature does not specify or describe the entrance/exit, the trainer must arrange one, however, both must not exceed 16 measures.
- I. The Contest Administrator and TWG will facilitate the conduct of the contest by giving necessary instructions for the smooth conduct of the contest.
- J. The decision of the board of judges is final and non-appealable.

No. of Participants: 4 learner-participants either from Key Stage 1 or 2 per school

Time Allotment: 3 to 5 minutes performance

Criteria for Presentation:

Musicality (Rhythm, Balance, Tonality and Harmony)	35%
Interpretation (Expression, Dynamics, Phrasing)	30%
Vocal Quality (Harmony)	25%
Showmanship (Stage presence)	10%
Total	100%

Event Rules and Mechanics:

- Himig Bulilit is a children's quartet exhibition.
- There will be one entry per school.
- The group should be composed of 4 Elementary learners (K to 6) per school. They shall sing and actively participate during the exhibition with one teacher coach.
- The group will sing two songs of their choice in the absence of the common piece.
- The group is encouraged to wear any appropriate attire.
- The Contest Administrator and TWG will facilitate the conduct of the contest by giving necessary instructions for the smooth conduct of the contest.
- The decision of the board of judges is final and non-appealable.

Note: Guidelines E, G and H of Sining Tangahalan will not apply in the division selection.

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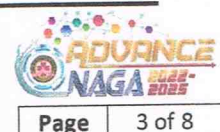

Event Rules and Mechanics:

- A. Guhit Bulilit is open to all learners who are officially enrolled in kindergarten.
- B. Only 1 kindergarten learner -participant per school is allowed.
- C. Participants may be accompanied by one teacher coach. However, they are allowed to assist the participants during the setting up of materials during the event.
- D. Participants should be at the venue on time.
- E. Materials shall be provided by the contestants.
- F. Participants are not allowed to bring photos for reference of their entries.
- G. The subject of the drawing shall be based on the theme which shall be given during the event.
- H. Participants shall use pencil and crayons on ten (10) inches by eight (8) inches (10 X 8) illustration board.
- I. Participants shall be given two hours to finish their artworks / outputs.
- J. The delivery is in the mother tongue / L1 for maximum of five minutes (Tell).
- K. The Contest Administrator and TWG will facilitate the conduct of the activity by providing instructions for the smooth conduct of the contest.
- H. The decision of the board of judges is final and non-appealable.

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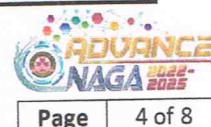
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
