The Universidad de Sta. Isabel de Naga, Inc. (USI) will be celebrating its 155th Foundation Anniversary come April 2023. One of its numerous activities is to replicate the project entitled, "Nagalakaw: A Walk-through History," which was spearheaded and implemented by the Nueva Caceres Heritage Movement Inc. (NCHM) in 2016. This project is a walking city tour of the seven (7) significant stations (plazas, schools, churches, etc.) that promote cultural heritage of Naga City, being one of the four Royal Cities declared by Spain in the Philippines. Tour guides will be bringing the tourists back to the Spanish era when Nueva Caceres was still a small city. Through this project, Nagueños and tourists will be linked to the glorious years of the city under Spanish rule.

Part of the USI's innovation for the project is to create a performance in every station. The last station will be the showcasing of the reenactment of the peaceful recapitulation of the surrender of the Spanish colonial government in Camarines which was held at Colegio de Sta. Isabel, now USI.

With all these, we deemed to honor the university and the historical places in Naga by reaching out to students, specifically grades 6, 10 and 12 and provide opportunities for learning the Bicol culture through our sponsorship of the Naga Lakaw on April 4, 2023.

The USI will invite educators, students, history groups, and other social-studies related groups from the different public and private schools in Naga City.

The registration fee for the walking tour is Php 250.00 for professionals and Php 200.00 for students to cover the history kit (certificate, fan, brochure map, bottled water, and cap.)

In addition, on April 11 and 12, 2023, the University will host an Open House and Academic Exhibit in order to allow the community to experience its historical aspects while also increasing public awareness of its numerous course options that represent excellence and service. As a result, the same invitation is deemed necessary.
