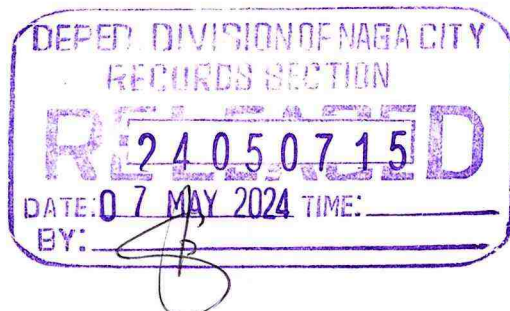
**PERMISSION TO CONDUCT VOCATION CAMPAIGN TO GRADE 12 LEARNERS OF
