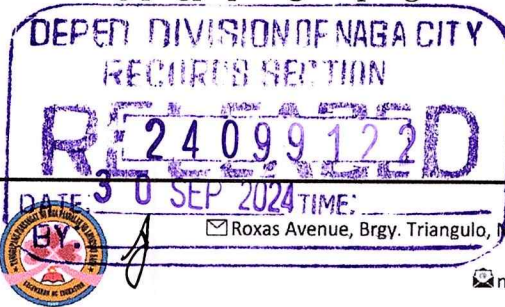

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, is again partnering with the two regional organizations of school paper advisers in Region V, Bicol Campus Journalism Association (BCJA), Inc. and Bicol Association of Campus Paper Advisers (BACPA), Inc., in the conduct of the last part of the three-series workshops on campus journalism this School Year 2024-2025. The REGIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOP ON MOBILE JOURNALISM AND TV SCRIPTWRITING AND BROADCASTING FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS IN REGION V (PART II) will be held at Charisma Hotel and Function Hall, Guinobatan, Albay on October 3-5, 2024.

2. In this three-day live-in training, two topics will be the focus of discussions and practicum: Mobile Journalism, and TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting.

3. The divisions are encouraged to send seasoned and potential school paper advisers from public and private elementary and secondary schools who are willing to undergo a thorough and rigorous training workshop for three days. The top five best outputs/presentations in mobile journalism and TV broadcasting will be given recognition during the Closing Program on October 5, 2024.

4. Every participant is expected to bring the following for mobile journalism: a cellphone with an editing app like Cupcut, etc.; a monopod or tripod or selfie stick, and a wireless or wired microphone compatible with the cellphone to be used by the participant.

5. For TV scriptwriting and broadcasting, every division team is expected to bring at least 3 laptops with one laptop installed with OBS and editing tools, a printer, 2 DSLR cameras with the tripod, 2 wireless microphones, a cellphone without SIM and installed with teleprompter application.

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6. To defray the cost of meals (3 breakfasts, 6 snacks, 3 lunches, 3 dinners), accommodation, hall rental, professional fees of resource persons, supplies and materials, a minimal registration fee amounting to FOUR THOUSAND AND TWO HUNDRED PESOS only (**Php 4,2000.00**) will be collected from the participants, payable to the two organizations, Bicol Campus Journalism Association Inc. (elementary level) and Bicol Association of Campus Paper Advisers Inc. (secondary level) upon their arrival at the venue on October 3, 2024.

7. The participants' expenses for the registration fee, travel, and miscellaneous expenses shall be charged against the division or school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE)/local funds/division or school campus journalism funds/downloaded campus journalism funds/ Special Education Funds/PTA Funds/other available funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private schools shall make arrangements with their respective schools regarding the expenses relevant to the participation in this training.

8. All participants are expected to arrive at the venue in the afternoon of October 2, 2024 and the first dinner to be served is dinner; while the last meal to be served is afternoon snacks on October 5, 2024.

9. Considering that October 5, 2024 is a Saturday, all teacher-participants are entitled to a one-day vacation service credit, in congruence to the provisions set in DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, re: updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers. On the other hand, the non-teaching personnel are entitled to receive a Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) for the accrued number of hours rendered on the same dates, as provided in CSC & DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, re: Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered.
