AMENDING CERTAIN PROCEDURES IN
 THE CONDUCT OF A SPECIAL CAREER
 EXECUTIVE SERVICE WRITTEN
 EXAMINATION (CESWE)

Resolution No. 1743

WHEREAS, Paragraphs 2 and 5, Article IV, Part III of the Integrated Reorganization Plan (IRP), as approved by Presidential Decree (PD) No. 1 (s. 1972), as amended, created the Career Executive Service Board (CESB) to serve as the governing body of the Career Executive Service (CES) and promulgate rules, standards, and procedures on the selection, classification, compensation, and career development of members of the CES;

WHEREAS, under the aforementioned law, the CES Governing Board is mandated to form a continuing pool of well-selected and development-oriented career administrators who shall provide competent and faithful service in the CES;

WHEREAS, the CES eligibility examination process, which is designed to ensure that entry to the CES is based on merit and fitness, consists of four (4) stages, viz: (1) CES Written Examination (CESWE); (2) Assessment Center; (3) Performance Validation; and (4) Panel Interview;

WHEREAS, the CESWE is the first of the four-stage CES Eligibility examination process designed to measure the applicant's general intelligence and knowledge of management concepts and principles. It is a paper and pencil type of exam composed of seven (7) subtests including the essay test;

WHEREAS, on 19 November 2020 during the time of COVID-19 pandemic, the CES Governing Board adopted and approved CESB Resolution Number 1561-B¹ to establish policy guidelines and procedures on the conduct of special examinations to protect and preserve the integrity and the security of examination materials, and ensure compliance to health and safety protocols;

WHEREAS, previous records show that requests for Special CESWE were accommodated to provide support in the succession planning efforts of various government agencies/offices;

WHEREAS, considering that the CESWE has already shifted back to the nationwide quarterly face-to-face conduct with around 250 to 300 examinees per batch and which requires administrative preparations for every conduct, it is necessary to amend certain procedures in the conduct of a Special CESWE;

Policy Guidelines on the Conduct of a Special CES Written Examination and Signing of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Requesting Agency, dated 19 November 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, the Board RESOLVES, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to amend Item No.1 of the procedures in the conduct of a Special CESWE, to read as follows:

The request for a Special CESWE must be made in writing, signed by the Agency Head and should specify the following details:

- a. *Reasons/justifications/purpose for the conduct of a Special CESWE, and urgency of the request;*
- b. *Preferred examination schedule;*
- c. *Approximate number of examinees (which should not be less than seventy-five (75) per conduct/batch for cost effectiveness and to maximize the administrative preparations and other examination-related arrangements. In case, it falls below the required number of examinees, the requesting agency may coordinate with the CES regional association and other government agencies in the region to invite other interested and qualified officials and employees to participate in the Special CESWE; and,*
- d. *Venue of the exam.*
- e. *Execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) specifying the expenses to be incurred in the conduct of a Special CESWE.*

The conduct of a Special CESWE shall be limited to two (2) batches per year considering that the nationwide face-to-face CESWE is scheduled quarterly and is held in three (3) testing centers (i.e. NCR, Cebu and Davao).

RESOLVED further that the CESB Executive Director is authorized to approve or disapprove requests for the conduct of Special CESWE, as well as enter into memoranda of agreement with requesting agencies.

APPROVED this 16th day of May 2024 in Quezon City, Philippines.
