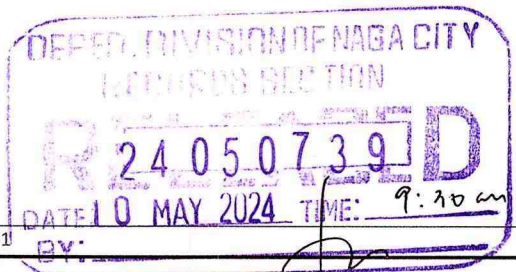

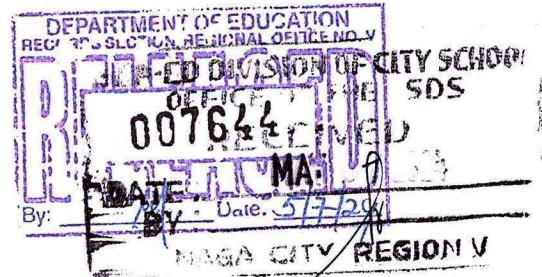

1. Identify science of teaching on different enabling policies introduced by Department of Education and how it benefits all school stakeholders;
2. Practice reflective teaching to recognize the need for self-improvement, updating of teaching philosophy and mindset;
3. Describe the significance of the recent K-12 curriculum review in response to the various challenges in basic education that led to the development into MATATAG Curriculum;
4. Apply constructive alignment in instructional planning to ensure the attainment of competencies expressed through the intended learning outcomes;
5. Unpack the MATATAG Curriculum competencies and scaffold the learning process to ensure that students are prepared for skills development;
6. Discuss how assessment literacy plays an important role in educational measurement;
7. Design alternative and authentic assessment using interdisciplinary approach to ensure the horizontal and vertical alignment of the lessons;
8. Use contextualization to promote 21st century skills and making meaning in every lesson;
9. Deduce how thinking and cognitive development is optimized by using strategies with body movement.
