

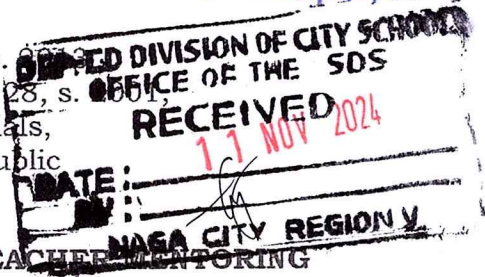

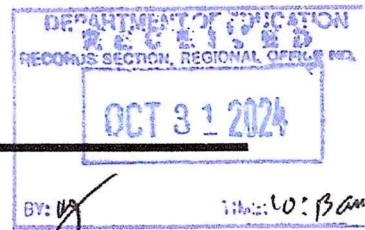

For the past 20 years, IPA has been at the forefront of rigorous research issues. In November 2023, IPA launched the [Best Bets: Emerging Opportunities for Impact at Scale](#) report fourteen innovations that IPA’s sector experts and scientific advisors believe hold the most promise for making require additional investment to advance along the path to scale.

### BEST BETS IN THE PHILIPPINES

IPA Philippines has chosen four Best Bets that are highly relevant in the Philippines: (i) **teacher mentoring to learning**, (ii) **digital payments to improve financial health**, (iii) **payment for ecosystem services to reduce protect the environment**, and (iv) **cognitive behavioral therapy to reduce crime**. Through a series of webinars into each of these best bets, explore their applicability in the Philippines together with key players in these respective academia, government, and civil society organizations. The webinar series will provide a platform to explore opportunities for research and collaboration.

### TEACHER MENTORING TO IMPROVE STUDENT LEARNING

In IPA’s best bets report, global evidence has shown that **teacher mentoring**, in which dedicated educational “teacher coaches” provide training, advice, and feedback to in-service teachers, is an effective intervention that increase student learning.

IPA Philippines is honored to guide this discussion and join forces to identify concrete collaboration opportunities and evidence base for teacher mentoring.
