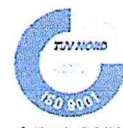

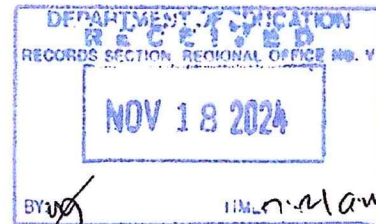



In line with the Department of Education's mandate to deliver quality basic education that is accessible to all, it has continuously engaged and collaborated with external partners in building the capacity of DepEd staff.
